Fees 2010/2011

Registration Fee: A non-returnable registration fee is payable when a pupil is registered for a place at Ellesmere College.

Fees: The comprehensive boarding and tuition fees cover all ordinary medical and nursing charges, subscription to the library, school meals, major games, swimming, the school magazine and laundry.

Deposits: A guarantee deposit is required when the formal offer of a place is made, which is credited to the first term's account. A returnable deposit is applied to the first term's account, which is credited to the final account when the pupil leaves the College.

International Students: For pupils whose first language is not English the school provides a professional and dedicated English as an additional language (EAL) service which is fully integrated into the weekly timetable. Upon arrival each pupil is assessed and an appropriate programme of lessons recommended.

Music: Termly fees for extra music are based on the rates for visiting music teachers recommended by the Incorporated Society of Musicians. There is a minimum of ten lessons per term.

Support for Learning: If parents request one-to-one lessons, or the Support for Learning Department recommends that lessons are necessary and proposes such lessons to parents, the termly rate will be:

Save for the above circumstances, lessons will be charged at the standard group rate, even in cases where one-to-one tuition applies because no partner is available for time-tabling purposes. The costs in such cases are:

Notice of Withdrawal: A term's notice in writing to the Headmaster on or before the first day of term, or payment of a term's school fees without any discounts, is strictly required before the removal of a pupil. The Headmaster reserves the right to require the removal of a pupil if, in his opinion, it is necessary in the interests of either school or pupil. No remission for the remainder of the term during which the pupil has been removed will be granted.

Payment: Fees are payable in advance together with any extras incurred in the previous term. All bills must be paid on or before the first day of each term, unless you join either the College Direct Debit Scheme or the Fees in Advance Scheme. Interest on an overdue account will be charged at 1.5% per month. The School Council reserves the right to refuse admittance to any pupil whose basic fee remains unpaid on the first day of term following that for which the fees are due.

Methods of Payment: Payments may be made by;

Direct Debit A no additional cost monthly payment scheme operated by the College.
