What is the course?

This course is for people looking to get involved in sports coaching, some experience is helpful but not necessary. This course can complement level 1 National Governing Body courses and bridge the gap to many level 2 National Governing Body courses. It provides a wide range of coaching skills that are not specific to a certain sport. Coaches with this qualification can work in after school clubs, holiday clubs and sports clubs where you as a coach would be expected to deliver many different sports.

What is covered on this course?

Units 1 - 8

- Contribute to organising and delivering a sports activity session
- Establish and maintain a safe sporting activity
- Understand the structure of sport and recreation at local, regional and national level
- Understand and lead fitness sessions
- Demonstrate principles and practice in running, sporting events and competitions
- Demonstrate principles and practice in adapting sports activities
- Plan a series of appropriate sporting activities
- Demonstrate leadership skills in the community

The Course

- The time of the course will be 9.30am - 6pm daily
- Participants must be 16 years or older
- 100% attendance is required to complete the course
- 10 hours demonstration of leadership in the community is required after completing the course
- Candidates are expected to work as a group during the course but also conduct individual plans and complete their workbook throughout the course.
- Candidates will be expected to deliver sessions to their peers and younger children throughout the course.

Booking Terms and Conditions

Commitment

This course requires 100% attendance.

Payment

To secure your booking, a non-refundable deposit of £50 must be returned with the application form. The balance of the course fees is due one week prior to the start of the course (Monday 2nd August).
