Dear Parents,

Our current Lower Sixth Sociology students have a modular exam on January 12th 2012. This module counts for 50% of their AS or 25% of the full A Level.

It is therefore vital that they do their best. The module will test them on all we have covered this term. Question 4 is worth 52% of the total marks. This question tests them on their understanding and evaluation of research methods used in a pre-released document which has just been sent by the exam board to all centres.

To help them prepare for that question we have already worked through a detailed way to answer it. They will be tested on it briefly in every lesson until the end of term. I also run daily lunchtime clinics for any who wish to go over any work.

As the exam takes place so early next term it is necessary for them to revise throughout the holiday. I would recommend at least an hour every day should be spent on Sociology. The VLE which all pupils can access from home also has a huge range of practice questions and self-marking tests. I would expect all to make full use of that. Any help they can be given at home to learn the way to answer it will be most useful.
