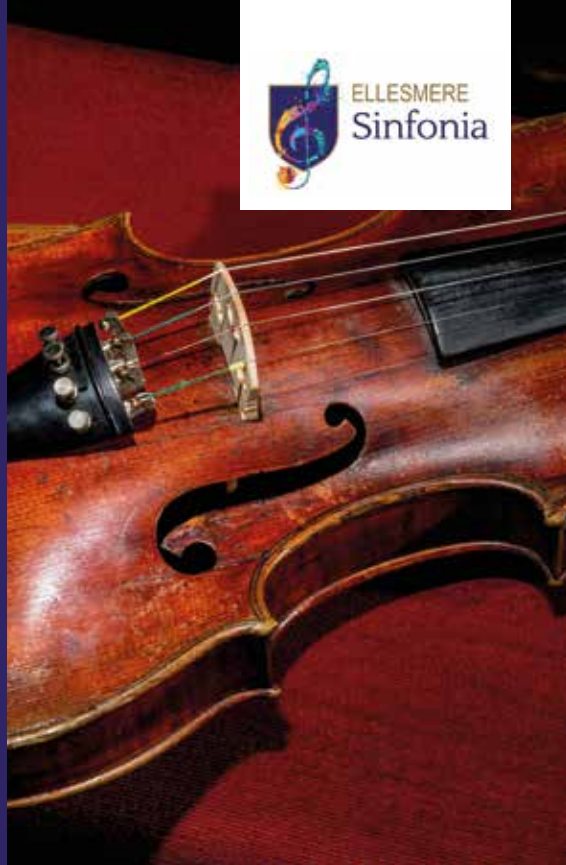
Ellesmere Sinfonia - Orchestral Music for a Winter's Evening
