**PEARSON BTEC NATIONAL DIPLOMA / EXTENDED DIPLOMA IN

(Commencing Sept 2021)**

How is the course structured?

BTEC National Diploma in Sport Coaching & Development

This course is a two year course which is equivalent to 2 A levels. Students need to complete nine units over the two years. There are six mandatory units and three optional. During the two years, three of the units are externally assessed either through a written examination or a controlled task set by the exam board. All students will complete the following units during the two years:

BTEC National Extended Diploma in Sport Coaching & Development

This course is a two year course which is equivalent to 3 A levels. Students need to complete fourteen units over the two years. There are ten mandatory units and four optional. During the two years, four of the units are externally assessed either through a written examination or a controlled task set by the exam board. All students will complete the following units during the two years:
